

JOB VACANCY
Technical Specialist Hydrogeology/Hydrology/Groundwater Chemistry

The Caribbean Institute for Meteorology and Hydrology (CIMH), in conjunction with the University of the West Indies (UWI) Cave Hill Campus, has received a grant to look at the impacts of recharge into karst sinkholes and dry wells/suck wells on the water quality of Barbados. To support this effort, CIMH seeks the service of a Technical Specialist specializing in hydrogeology/hydrology and geochemical transport processes. In particular, candidates should have experience related to simulating pesticides and fertilizer transport in karst limestone geologies. Experience in project management would also be an asset.

Candidates for the position should have at least a M.Sc. in Hydrogeology, Environmental Engineering, Hydrology, Geochemistry or Water Chemistry and two (2) years of practical experience. Candidates with B.Sc. First Class or Upper Seconds Honours degree and more than five (5) years practical experience in any of the specializations mentioned may also be considered for the position.
